REPORT ON THE 6th FEALAC SOCIAL-POLITICAL COOPERATION AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT WORKING GROUP MEETING Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic November 7, 2019

- 1. The 6th Meeting of the Working Group on Social-Political Cooperation and Sustainable Development (SPCSD) of FEALAC was held in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic on November 7th, 2019.
- 2. The Meeting was co-chaired by Amb. Xinia Vargas, Ambassador of Costa Rica in Dominican Republic; and Li Cuiying, Counsellor of Department of Latin American and Caribbean Affairs of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of China.
- 3. The Meeting was attended by delegates from 16 countries. The list of delegates is attached below (Annex 1).
- 4. In their opening remarks, the Co-Chairs welcomed the participation of the member countries in the sixth meeting of the Working Group on Social-Political Cooperation and Sustainable Development (SPCSD). The Co-Chairs reiterated that last year in Lao PDR, we have put forward many designs for projects based on sound exchanges on issues such as promoting East Asia-Latin America dialogue and sustainable development and hope that member countries propose more ideas and projects for more cooperation between the two regions.
- 5. The Co-Chairs conveyed the Working Group's appreciation for the excellent meeting arrangements made by Dominican Republic.
- 6. The attached agenda was adopted (Annex 2).
- 7. Under the leadership of China and Costa Rica, 18 projects were completed or ongoing since the 8th FMM, which includes 10 national projects and 2 regional projects. Beyond 9th FMM, 6 new projects have been presented to be implemented, and the Co-Chairs encourage the countries to propose new projects.
