The 9th FEALAC Cyber Secretariat Workshop

The 9th FEALAC Cyber Secretariat Workshop was held under the theme of 'FEALAC 20 years and Beyond'. 74 delegates from 32 member countries attended the year's workshop. During this workshop, participants presented and analyzed ways that can help FEALAC to leap forward in light of 20 year anniversary, studied cases of permanent secretariats of international organizations to facilitate the consideration of setting up permanent secretariat, and lastly discussed logistics and other details of this year's Foreign Ministers' Meeting in the Dominican Republic.



The 9th FEALAC Cyber Secretariat Workshop took place on March 26, 2019 in Seoul, Korea. The first and the case study session were moderated by Mr. Yungjoon Jo (Director General, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Korea). Speakers from Lao PDR, Ecuador, Indonesia, Japan, China, Argentina and Cyber Secretariat presented on progress on New FEALAC Action Plan. In the special case study session, Juan Ignacio Siles, Director of Ibero-American Secretariat, presented the operation of the Ibero-American Secretariat, followed by a presentation from Cyber Secretariat who presented other cases of permanent secretariats of international organizations. During the second session, which was moderated by Mr. Virasac Somphong (Director General, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Lao PDR), speakers from Dominican Republic, Peru, Ecuador, Thailand, Costa Rica and Mongolia gave their presentations on ways to improve FEALAC in light of its 20th Anniversary. During this meeting, participants also shared their suggestions for this year's Foreign Ministers' Meeting given that this year marks the 20th anniversary of FEALAC.

In addition, an interim Coordination Meeting was held the day after the workshop, participated by Indonesia, Ecuador, China, Costa Rica, Thailand, Mexico, Japan, Panama, Guatemala, Argentina, Korea, Cyber Secretariat and the two Regional Coordinators from Dominican Republic and Lao PDR, where participants discussed details and logistics of this year's Foreign Ministers' Meeting.

Overall, 74 participants from 32 member countries made this workshop especially fruitful by engaging in insightful and encouraging discussions throughout the sessions.
